

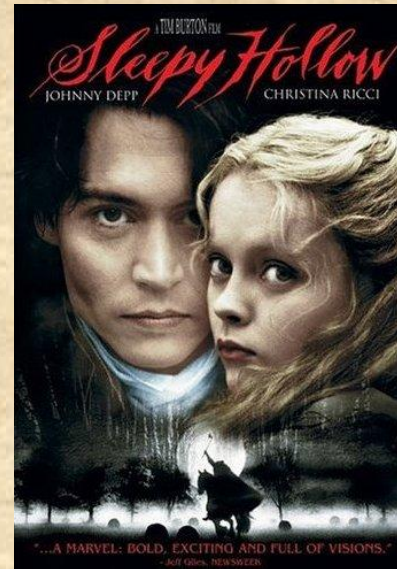


10th Grade US Literature
