During the coming weeks, students will hone reading, writing, and speaking skills simultaneously through textual analysis and a series of oral presentations about their own values and beliefs.

They will dramatize their readings to demonstrate and underscore comprehension and to develop confidence and pronunciation. Through essay-writing workshops, they will also grow in their capacity to organize their ideas and write a persuasive essay.



Students will find that readings and activities will center around dark themes; they will begin the semester with Jonathan Edwards' "Sinner in the Hands of an Angry God" before moving on to a study the Salem Witch Trials and a mock witch-hunt. They will analyze the poetry of Phyllis Wheatley and immerse themselves in the short stories of Edgar Allen Poe.
